NOTICE OF PROPOSAL

Kelowna, British Columbia - Airspace and Air Traffic Services Requirements

GENERAL

Pursuant to Section 15 of the Civil Air Navigation Services Commercialization Act, S.C. 1996, c. 20 (the ANS Act), this document provides notice of NAV CANADA's proposal to amend civil air navigation services in the vicinity of Kelowna Airport, British Columbia.

Persons interested in making representations to NAV CANADA about the proposal set out in this Notice may do so by writing to the address set out under Section 2. NAV CANADA must receive representations no later than January 6, 2025 January 21, 2025.

This Notice consists of two Sections:

- (1) Particulars of the Proposal
- (2) Making Representations to NAV CANADA.

1. PARTICULARS OF THE PROPOSAL

Following the conduct of an Aeronautical Study, NAV CANADA proposes the following amendments to civil air navigation services in the vicinity of the Kelowna Airport, British Columbia:

- Modify the Kelowna CZ dimensions, add a shelf at the north and south end of the CZ, and redesignate as Class C airspace,
- Extend a portion of CYA 122 to the west from the surface to 4,500 feet ASL, and add a flight training symbol (T) to the CYA description,
- Eliminate the Alpine, Valhalla, and Wildcat Helicopters Air Traffic Frequency (ATF) areas and establish a single ATF area for helicopters in West Kelowna and depict on the VTPC. Change Ikon Adventures ATF frequency to 126.7,
- Explore revising and updating the Kelowna VTPC, including VFR routes and waypoints.
