# What's New in NAV Drone Web

The following changes were made to the NAV Drone Web application:

## Operation Flight Report Improvements

Changes to the PDF Flight Report document include:

- Times are displayed in both local and UTC time
- NAV CANADA logo added to the form
- Remarks have been moved to the top of the report

## Strategic Deconfliction

When a user's operation plan conflicts with other planned drone operations or active geozones, the Web App helps users to deconflict by showing timeline alternatives.

## Operations Timeline

An event timeline has been added to the operation screen. The event timeline currently displays take off and landing events with more events to be added in future releases.

## Distance Calculator

Users can now also perform measurements when planning a New operation or in the Flightmap using the Distance Calculator feature.

## Pin Operations

To simplify planning of recurring operations, users can now Pin an existing Operation in the Operations overview. Pinned operations always appear at the top of the Operations overview and at the top of the operations list that appears when the user plans a new operation based on an existing one.

## Path Width Adjustment

Users can edit the width of a Path shape by:

1. Right click the path shape and select **Edit**
2. Drag the cursor to the edge of the shape
3. Click and drag to desired width
4. Release mouse button

## Other UI Improvements

- Updated Toasters – toasters have a new look
- Updates to Operation screen – The Operation screen layout changed in order to accommodate the event timeline
- Operations sorting – In the Operations overview, operations are sorted by default on Start time.
- Selectable cards for Pilot/Drone - The fields Drone and Drone Pilot in the Operation parameters have turned into info cards showing all relevant information when planning an operation.
- Renamed *Create operation* to *Plan operation*
