NOTICE OF PROPOSAL Windsor, Ontario

GENERAL

Pursuant to Section 15 of the Civil Air Navigation Services Commercialization Act, S.C. 1996, c. 20 (the ANS Act), this document provides notice of NAV CANADA's proposal to amend civil air navigation services in the vicinity of Windsor Airport, Ontario.

Persons interested in making representations to NAV CANADA about the proposal set out in this Notice may do so by writing to the address set out under Section 2. Such representations must be received by NAV CANADA no later than July 27, 2022.

This Notice consists of two Sections:

- (1) Particulars of the Proposal
- (2) Making Representations to NAV CANADA.

1. PARTICULARS OF THE PROPOSAL

Following the conduct of an Aeronautical Study, NAV CANADA proposes the following amendments to civil air navigation services in the vicinity of Windsor Airport, Ontario:

- Reducing daily hours of operation for Windsor Airport Control Tower and associated Airport
 Control Service and Vehicle Control Service to 15 hours per day with service to be provided 0700
 to 2200 local time (1200Z to 0300Z during standard time and 1100Z to 0200Z during daylight
 savings time) (the Daily Site Opening Hours); and
- Increasing the Mandatory Frequency hours to reflect the amended Daily Site Opening Hours.
